



CTCC Community Days Booth Rules and Regulations

CTCC Community Days for booths will be held on Saturday July 11, 2009 in the Cranberry Community Park, Route 19 in Cranberry Township from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 pm. Booths are expected to open at 3:00 PM and remain open until at least 8:00 PM, ideally until 10:30 PM. Booth participants are also encouraged to remain open throughout the entire evening as many spectators gather in the park after 8:00 pm for the fireworks display at 9:30 pm, and remain after the fireworks.

Rental space information and parking pass will be available to be picked up at the Parks & Recreation desk in the Cranberry Township Municipal Center during regular business hours beginning June 22, 2009.

Applications

All applications for rental space or sponsorship of an event/activity must be made payable to on or web site www.CTCChest.org or at **CTCC Cranberry Community Days** and mailed to: **CTCC Cranberry Community Days Committee, 2525 Rochester Road, Suite 600, Cranberry Twp., PA 16066.**

Participants

All participants must complete an application form describing type of booth and a description of items for sale. Participating for profit businesses **must agree to donate 25%** of their profits for the day or \$100 whichever is less, to the CTCC Community Days Committee. All applications are subject to the approval of the CTCC Community Days Committee.

Booth Location

The Cranberry Community Days Committee will do its best to give everyone their selected booth but we reserve the ultimate right to designate the placement of all participants. **Booths may be set up on July 10th between the hours of 2:00 PM and 4:30 PM or July 11th between 12:00 pm-2:30 pm.** Security will be provided by the Committee.

Parking

All participating organizations and businesses will be issued a parking permit. Senior Citizen and Handicapped parking will be available. **Vehicles will be permitted on the grounds during set-up on July 11, 2009 beginning at 12:00 pm. All vehicles must be moved to the designated parking areas by 2:30 pm.** We will provide one parking pass for parking after 2:30 PM, a second pass can be purchased for \$10.

Electricity

Limited electricity will be provided in designated areas where available. Electricity is included in the booth price of \$100.

Public Safety

All booths using a gas or electrical appliances must have a first aid kit and a fire extinguisher. Items for sale must meet safety standards determined by the Committee. Silly string and/or snaps; cap, top, and squirt guns; knives; swords; and/or other related items are not permitted for safety reasons. The Committee reserves the right to deny the sale of items that may threaten public safety. **Vendors are prohibited from bringing or using any style of motorized vehicle in the park.**

Raffle or Contests

Raffles must be drawn by 7:00 pm and winners announced by 8:00 pm. The Committee must receive a list of all raffle and contest winners name and phone number by 7:30 pm.
