CTCC TREASURE HUNT OFFICAL RULES

1. NO DIGGING! The key will be placed on public lands.
2. No purchase is necessary,
3. Participants less than 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult to win the prizes.
4. To claim the prize, winners must be present with the OFFICIAL key at the Community Stage at Community Park on Saturday July 11th, 2009 by 3:15 PM. The Official Key is coded on the back and cannot be duplicated. Prizes will be delivered by July 20th, 2009 or sooner. The lunch with Steelers Jack Ham and Bills John Skorupan must be arranged to the schedule of Jack Ham/John Skorupan within 2009. Every attempt will be made to be flexible on the schedule. Cancellation or no-show of the winner on a scheduled lunch will void this prize.
5. The persons and organizations conducting the contest will determine the official winners and their decision shall be final. There will be one official winner, though groups are welcome to participate in the Treasure Hunt.
6. No digging or destruction of property allowed. Key will be hidden within the boundaries marked as public lands. All State, Local and Federal Laws apply. Any taxes if applicable will be the responsibility of the winner.
7. All prizes are awarded "as is." Gifts are nontransferable and cannot be exchanged. There is no substitution nor can the prizes be sold privately or publicly. Any prized not redeemed by Jan. 12, 2010 is void.
8. The CTCC Community Days Committee shall not be responsible for the failure of participating sponsors to deliver prizes as promised, but will work with you to help claim prizes.
9. Violation of any of these rules or attempts to win this contest by fraud, deception, or cheating shall be grounds for disqualification.
10. The Treasure Hunt is open to anyone living inside or outside of Cranberry Twp. Members of CTCC and Butler Eagle and their immediate families are not eligible to participate in the treasure hunt.
11. In the unlikely event that the key is not located or the key is not submitted by the time and date above, we may hold another Treasure Hunt later and roll over the prizes if possible.

How the Contest will work!

1. Starting on Wednesday June 3rd, we will provide a numbered Clue to solving the Treasure Hunt. This first clue will appear in The Cranberry Eagle in a specific ad clearly labeled as CTCC Treasure Hunt. The Clues will appear on every Sunday & Wednesday issue of the Cranberry Eagle and the last Clue will be Sunday July 5th, 2009. Two additional Clues will be given in June, one in a video that will be posted on our CTCC

web site and another in our Annual Report that will be mailed to every home in Cranberry and Seven Fields. For those participants out of this area, we will also post our Annual Report on the CTCC web site at www.CTCChest.org

2. It is not necessary to solve the Clues in a specific order. While the Clues will be numbered, this is being done to reference the clue and assure you that you do have all 12 clues. The key could be found only with partial clues solved or without later clues to be submitted.
3. Some of the Clues will not be solvable by sitting at home and will require a search around town. Care should be taken when searching for answers to clues.
4. When all the clues are solved, there still will be work to do to find the key.
5. There will be a phone number with the key. This will be your opportunity to pre-approve the key before the July 11th 2009 3:15 PM deadline. Pre-approving the key does not complete the contest or declare a winner. The participant must present the key at the Community Stage as described above.
6. Every attempt will be made to put the clues on CTCC & Cranberry Eagle web site within 3 days in case you miss an issue of the Cranberry Eagle. Past issues of The Cranberry Eagle can be found in The Cranberry Twp Municipal Building, libraries, and at the offices of The Cranberry Eagle on Route 19 in Cranberry.
